


What's This All About?



The golden shimmering Aspens have to

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 13 We'll
assemble at newly-renovated La Fonda, a
luxury hotel located on the historic 1609
Plaza in downtown Santa Fe. La Fonda is
an Historic Hotel of America, designed by
architect Isaac Hamilton Rapp, who creat-
ed the Pueblo Revival Style with this 1922
Grand Hotel and his nearby New Mexico
Museum of Art.

If you're driving in, Santa Fe is eas-
ily reached from I-40 or I-25, and we can
safely leave tow rigs for the week. If you're
flying in, we'll pick you up at Santa Fe Air-
port or Albuquerque International Sunport.

Jean has booked rooms starting Fri-
day night, and we urge you to arrive early
to explore the Santa Fe Historic District,
including Palace of the Governors, Georgia
O'Keeffe Museum and Loretto Chapel.

Sunday afternoon, we've planned
an optional Odometer Calibration Loop
that visits Valles Caldaras, Jemez Pueblo
and famous Range Cafe in Bernalillo before
returning to overnight at La Fonda and
Dinner in Isaac Rapp's equally-charming
Museum of Art.



MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

We'll drive spectacular back roads North through Kit Carson National Forest and Rio Grande National Forest to historic Telluride. The shimmering golden Aspens as you drive up the mountain will take your breath away! We're planning dinner and overnight at luxurious The Peaks Resort in Telluride Mountain, overlooking marvelous sunset views.

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15

We'll drive on some of the best sports car roads in the world on our way to Arches National Park. After lunch near Moab, we'll rally on a famously "twisty and steep" route to billionaire John Hendricks' Gateway Canyons Resort. Dinner and overnight at upscale Gateway Canyons.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16



